Bio

Borned in Puerto Rico in 1975, I grew up in a family with a deep social and political conscience. My parents and uncles were engaged in movements against the Vietnam War, environmental destruction, social oppression, and colonialism. My father was an important leader in the proindependence youth movement, then became a college professor in journalism and the founder and director of various important publications. My mother, a clinical psychologist, works as a teacher in the biggest and poorest housing project in the island. I lived in Buenos Aires during the military regime and the Falkland War. I travelled to Cuba at the age of ten to take part in a summer camp for world peace. There I met children and youth from all over the world, and it was then that I started to comprehend in a more profound way the sense of solidarity and fraternity – ideals that I have adopted as my life principles.

I graduated from the Interdisciplinary Studies program at the University of Puerto Rico in Río Piedras, where I took part in the student movement as an organizer and communicator. There, I was part of the theatre ensemble – a group that recruit me to give different workshops in marginalized communities throughout Puerto Rico. During my student years, I also travelled to study with legendary theatre ensembles, such as, the Bread and Puppet Theatre in Vermont and the Yuyachkani in Peru. Moreover, at the university, I met and worked with one of the great historians of our country, jesuit priest Dr. Fernando Picó, Ph.D., also famous for his committed work with prisoners. As part of this work, we supported prisoners in developing their own publication entitled, Nuestro Camino ("Our Path,","Our Way", or "Our Road"). In 1996 I won a scholarship to study as an exchange student in City University of New York, where I continued studies in film, philosophy, art, and history, and worked in the Center For Puerto Rican Studies as an assistant to Ramón Bosque Pérez in the book "Las Carpetas," a research project about political persecution and civil liberties violations in Puerto Rico.

In 2001, I began working as a director, videographer, and editor in the award-winning environmental show Geoambiente, on which I travelled through the island's natural habitats and cities, working with scientists and communities to reflect on current environmental challenges. In 2004, a group of filmmakers founded a nonprofit called Proyecto Chiringa, and our first project consisted of shooting a documentary entitled, "30,000" -- on the disappeared victims of the "Dirty war" perpetuated by the Argentine military Junta regime.

Moreover, in 2005, we continued our collaboration on the feature documentary, "Aljuriya," which examined the Israeli-Palestinian conflict from the perspective of activists involved in the struggle against the Israeli occupation of Palestine. I was also recognized for the Emmy Award-winning musical feature "Sonó, Sonó, Tite Curet" (2011), the biographical profile of a legendary musical composer and his legacy throughout Latin America and New York. In 2014, I was the recipient of the International Fund Doctv for a feature documentary entitled, "Armonía" about the struggle of a small town laid-off music teacher and a famous Puerto Rican jazz musician that teamed up to save his community's public music program.

In 2005, I founded Rojo Chiringa and began a career as music video director and full-time filmmaker. I have worked with renown international artists such as Calle 13, Rubén Blades, Nelly Furtado, and rapidly became a multiple award-winning director and producer. I have collaborated with fellow directors in commercial ads, music videos, documentaries, and fiction.

My work experience has put me in contact with numerous local and international artists. I have worked in communities throughout the island with important, community-based nonprofits such as, Casa Pueblo, INE, and Proyecto Enlace del Caño Martín Peña. I have also managed large budget and broadcasting projects.

I was instrumental in Bernie Sanders grassroots campaign in Puerto Rico, deciding and preparing the agenda for his visit, recruiting, coordinating volunteers, consolidating groups, producing videos, crowdfunding, designing propaganda and elaborating an electoral strategy.

My unbreakable commitment and professional ethics have earned me high recognition and distinction. Today, the collective I founded is well-renowned as one of the top production companies of the island specializing in social and cultural content.
